Goals for Seminars Offering CE credits

Continuing education (CE) in psychology is an ongoing process consisting of formal learning activities that (1) are relevant to psychological practice, education and science, (2) enable psychologists and other health care professionals to keep pace with emerging issues and technologies, and (3) allow health care professionals to maintain, develop, and increase competencies in order to improve services to the public and enhance contributions to the profession.

Curriculum Content for Seminars Offering CE credits

The content of continuing education is the crucial component of programs intended to maintain, develop, and increase conceptual and applied competencies that are relevant to psychological practice, education, and science. WPSP's CE programs may include content related to well-established psychological principles, or may be based on content that extends current theory, method, or practice. CE programs may provide information related to ethical, legal, statutory or regulatory policies, guidelines, and standards that impact psychology.

Membership Requirements

All seminar participants must be dues paying members of WPSP.

Confidentiality

Seminar participants will fully respect patient confidentiality when clinical material is presented in connection with the course of study.
